



HEALTH ANNOUNCEMENT

Greetings! The administration at the Princeton Senior Resource Center has been following recent developments regarding Covid-19 (Coronavirus) through local, state, and federal health officials. Below is the current guidance to deter the spread of the virus. At this time, we have not cancelled any programs nor closed our facilities. However, we will be tracking the situation very closely and will provide regular updates as the situation unfolds.

First, it is important to note that “the risk of novel coronavirus is not at all connected with race, ethnicity, or nationality.” (CDC) As a community, it is important that we allow our commitment to an inclusive and welcoming environment to guide us as we move forward.

Second, please know the symptoms of COVID-19 and respond accordingly. These symptoms include fever, cough, and respiratory distress. The spread of the virus is typically from person-to-person via respiratory droplets from coughing or sneezing (similar to the flu). Surface/object transfer is also possible.

- **If you are symptomatic, please do not come to PSRC programs (including Evergreen Forum) and please do seek appropriate medical attention.** If someone exhibiting these symptoms does come to our programs, they will be asked to leave and we will necessarily contact the local health department for guidance.
- **Please cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue or a sleeve.** Tissues should immediately be disposed of in one of the many available trash receptacles.
- **Please wash your hands with soap and water regularly.** Please use alcohol based hand sanitizer often. Dispensers are located throughout the building.
- **Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed/unsanitized hands.**
